

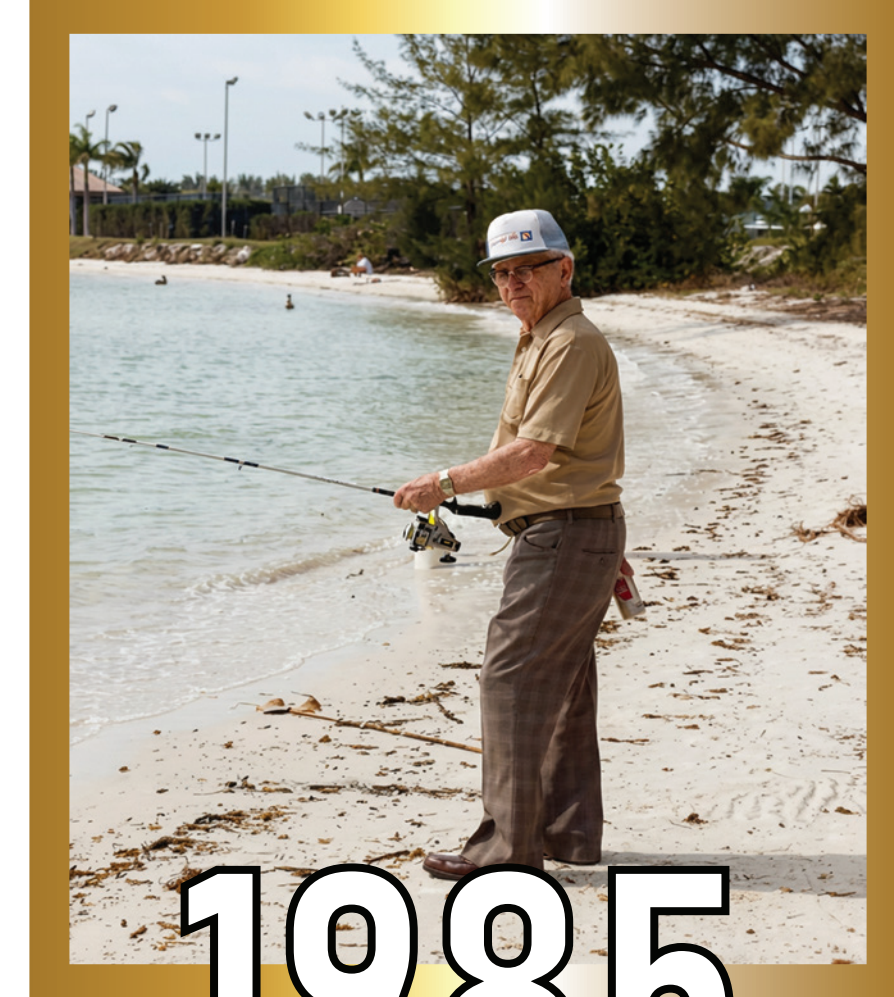
1946

Ed Doyle passes away and is survived by his nine children.



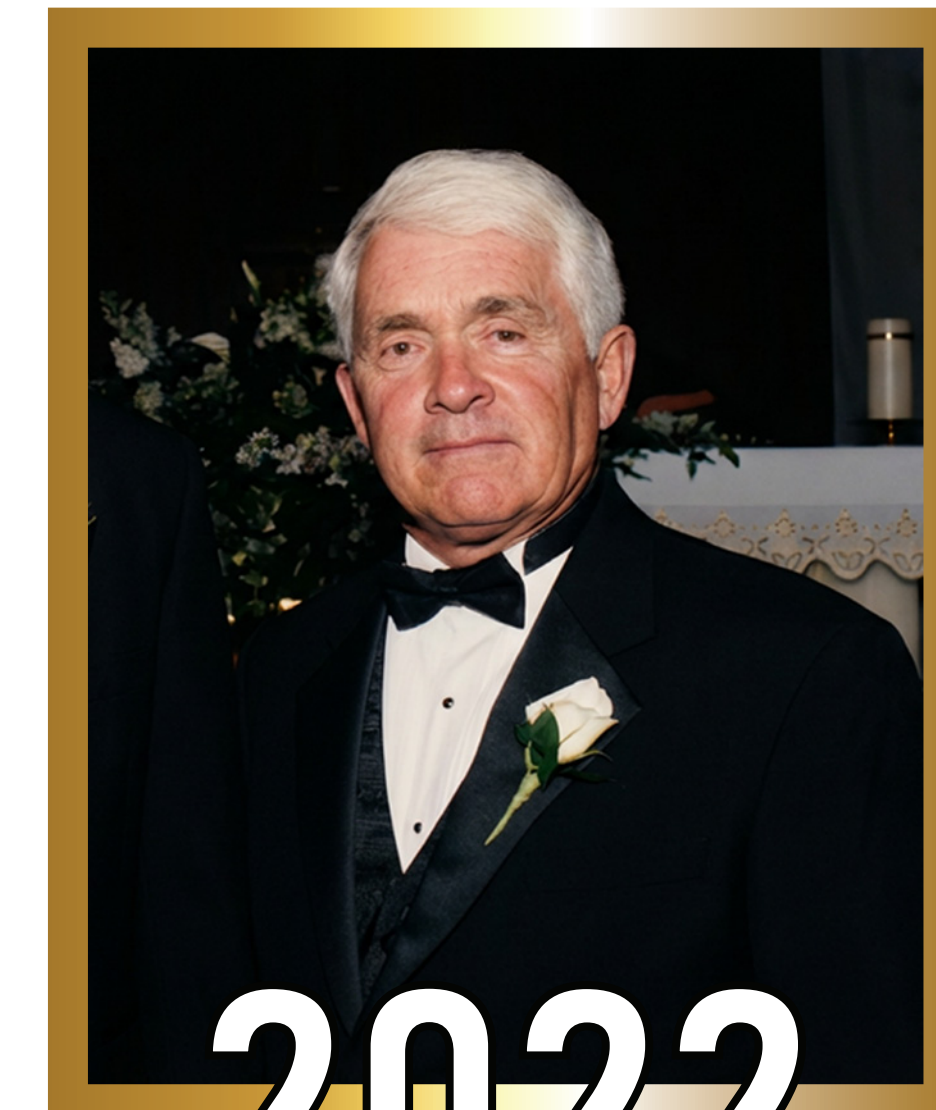
2010
